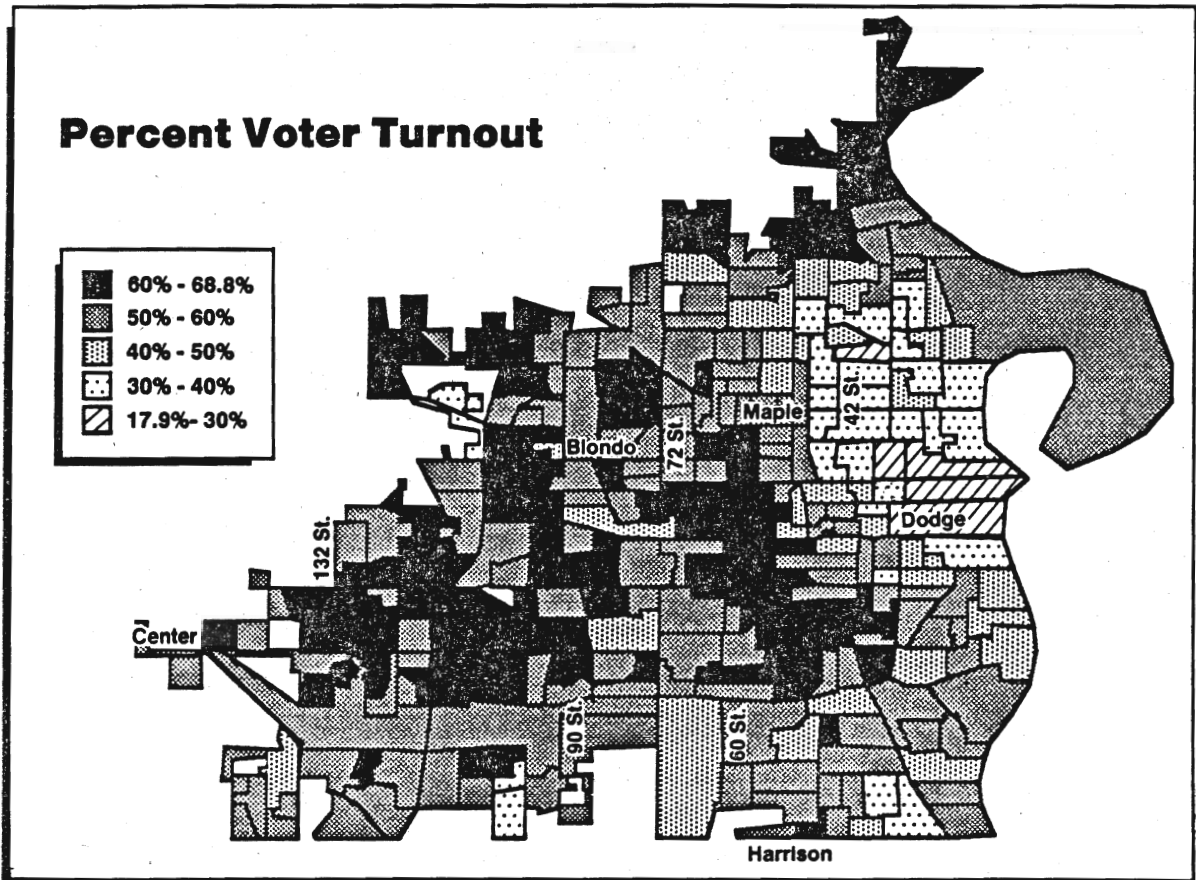


Boyle Did Poorest Where Vote Biggest

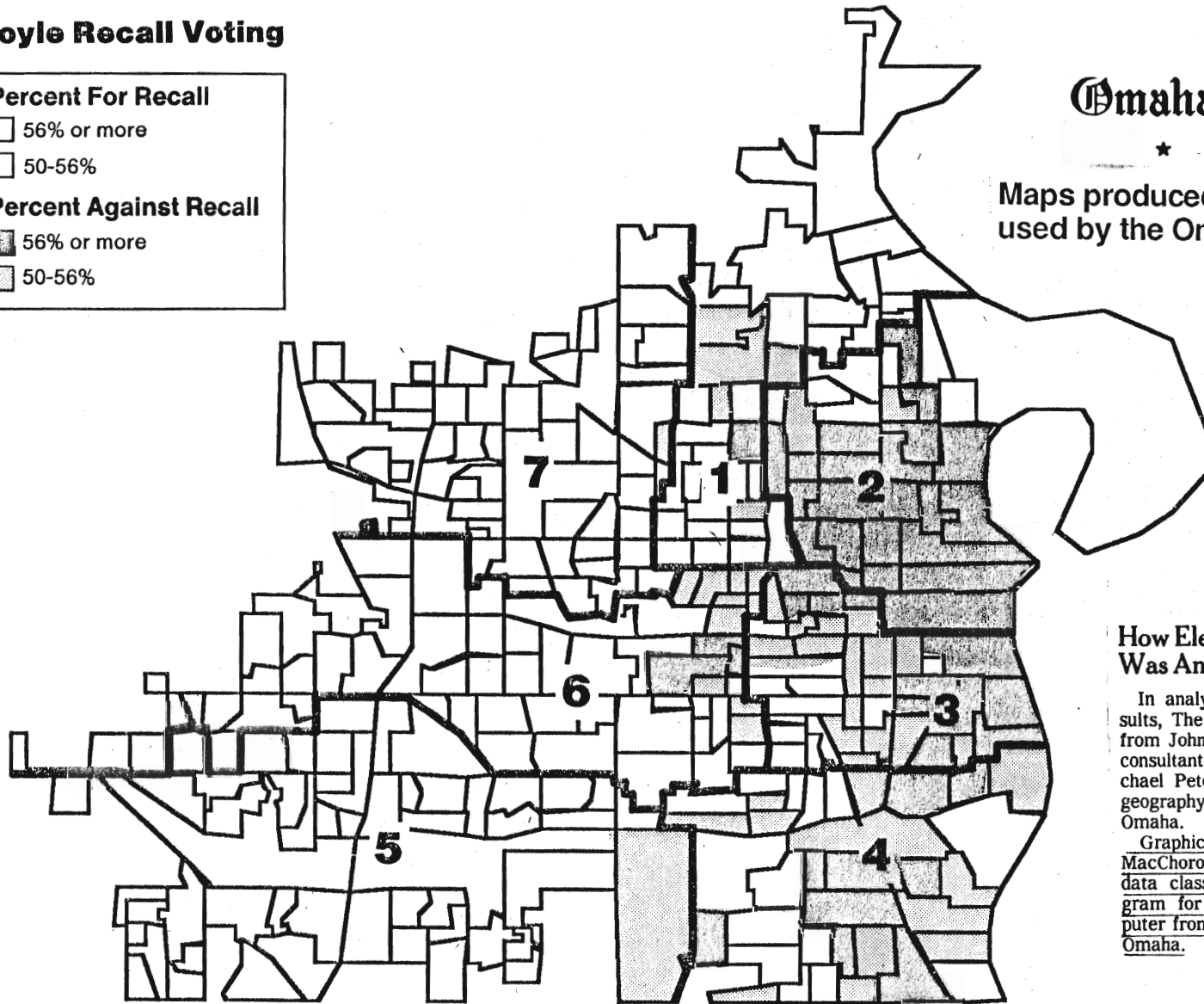
Boyle Recall Voting
